## Theatre Production 2024 - Company Contract

***I understand that in accepting a role in ORHS Theatre production, I will adhere to the following:***

Advanced Theatre Production is a double blocked course responsible for the production of all ORHS Theatre Performances. Students are given the opportunity to learn and participate in all aspects of Theatre (Acting, Musical Theatre, Makeup, Costume, Lights & Sound) to grow and gain confidence in their craft. Theatre Production participates in UIL, Texas Thespians and several other activities throughout the school year. Below is a list of requirements, rules and expectations for this class. Parents & Students need to initialize each bullet point & sign the bottom of the page.

- \_\_\_\_\_ Maintain a passing grade in all of my other courses and follow all of my teachers' classroom procedures and rules.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Those of you enrolled in the Theatre Production course (7th & 8th Period) is because your presence in class is crucial, avoid using 7th & 8th period as a study hall or make-up work time in class—although under extreme or dire circumstances, make-up work (tests, re-tests, and quizzes) can be scheduled during the *7th or 8th* period. In general, however, you should try to arrange make-up work time with your teachers during Eagles Nest.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Treat all members of the company with professional courtesy and respect at all times, as you expect to be treated.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Abide by all school rules per the student code of conduct regarding on and/or off-campus behavior. ,
- \_\_\_\_\_ I will have MY supplies at all times including scripts, pencils, pens, makeup kits etc.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I acknowledge that the play and/or my role in the company may be changed *at any time for any reason* at the discretion of the directors. If I am constantly leaving school early and missing class without communicating with your directors you may be asked to move to a lower level Theatre class.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I will keep my parents/guardians informed of the rehearsal schedule, particularly if there are any last minute changes.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I agree to assist with the production of all shows in any capacity, (understudying, costumes,makeup, front of house, cleaning up, set build/strike, etc). Students are required to work on crew for each show if not cast.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I understand that I may be personally responsible for parts of my costume and makeup and for proper storage of them.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I understand that I am part of a team effort, so I must have a positive attitude, even on days when I have a million reasons to not be open-minded and willing to work.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I understand this class requires collaboration, and I agree to contribute my ideas and energy at appropriate times.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I understand the director will make final choices pertaining to my role(s).
- \_\_\_\_\_ I agree to do all that I can to make rehearsals the best they can be.

**Use of Social Media & Text Messaging:** this permission process is required by CISD: By initialing here and signing below, my parent/guardian gives ORHS Theatre permission to use photographic, audio, or video recordings of the student in any video or audio recordings, including streamed productions, publicity materials for productions, or other recordings used in official CISD websites, Facebook, Twitter, or any department-related web presences. ORHS administrators will have full access to social media pages at all times in order to monitor the site. By signing this form, you give permission for your student to be a member of these groups. CISD also requires all organizations to receive permission for students involved in extracurricular activities to receive text messages from sponsors through BAND APP ONLY. These messages would only be sent in regards to scheduling, departure/arrival times for trips, rehearsals, reminders, etc.

**BAND APP:** You should also download the Band app. By checking the box, you grant permission for your student to join the private Band group. Parents should also download the Band App and join the "Troupe 4122" as well as the "Production 24-25" Band group. Your student can invite you by joining, then texting you an invite to the group.

**Disciplinary Actions:** If students are found breaking the Oak Ridge Code of Conduct it will result in a possible referral, ISS, DAEP and immediate removal from the Production Class. This includes but is not limited to Vaping, Drug or Alcohol use, skipping, fighting and bullying.

If students fail to adhere to the contract and rules of the department, The directors will meet with the student and their parents to discuss a last chance contract. The Next step after that will be removal from the production class.
